We are into the spring season and the weather has been VERY warm during the days. There is still great snow cover from the staging areas, although the parking areas are getting bare. Riders should be expecting spring like conditions from now until seasons end. Please understand that we are always doing the best we can with the trails in the current weather conditions.

Watch out for afternoon sun warming and please check the conditions for your area at www.avalanche.ca before heading out for your days ride.

Allan: is still being maintained and will be groomed Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Wednesday evenings, barring unforeseen circumstances.

Clemina: is still accessible although will not be groomed this week due to very warm weather and low snow on the first 4km. The groomer is being moved to 4km and I will inspect the first 4km on Friday to make the decision for a weekend groom. The upper section of the trail is in great shape, the bottom is just very warm and slushy.

Chappell Creek: will be groomed again this upcoming weekend and still holds great snow cover on the trail.

Keyhole: Logging is still going on this area and we are unable to groom. Please remember that it is illegal to operate a snowmobile on a plowed road. Radio contact is a must if you insist on driving up this road to the snowline.
